

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IF HE/SHE :

Has vomited or had diarrhea the night before or in the morning before school

Has a fever of 100 degrees or above. Student must be fever free for 24hrs. without use of anti-fever medication before allowed to return to school. Please do not administer anti-fever medication to student for fever before school and send the student to school.

Has a rash that has not been diagnosed or is uncomfortable

Has itching, redness or pus draining from one or both eyes, not related to allergies

Is coughing uncontrollably or coughing up mucus

Has head lice. Any student sent home with active head lice must be brought to the school clinic by an adult and checked by nurse or personnel for absence of active head lice before the student is permitted back to class.

Has scabies that are untreated. Scabies should be treated with prescribed medication for 24hrs. before student returns to class.

*** Students that are required to go home due to illness or medical need are expected to be picked up promptly. Please ensure there are emergency contacts listed that can pick up your student promptly in the event you are unable to do so.**
